The seminar is held within the framework of the project «**Boosting Local Economic Growth in Border Regions in the Process of EU Integration: Best Practices of Eastern Partnership (EaP) Countries**» (№ 599948-EPP-1-2018-1-UA-EPPJMO-SUPPA) implemented under Jean Monnet - Support to Associations - ERASMUS+ Programme. The scientific and practical seminar aims to boost experience exchange in the issues related to cross-border cooperation research in conditions of current challenges and discuss the opportunities and perspectives of increasing its efficiency and effectiveness. The ways the cross-border cooperation tools can be used in practice by bordering territorial communities, newly created districts and oblasts of Ukraine, and their foreign partners will also be addressed. The researchers and experts from Ukraine, Romania, Moldova, Poland, Slovakia, and other countries are invited to participate in the event.

The program and proceedings (abstracts) of speeches will be published before the start of the seminar.

The organizers provide meals and conference materials. Participants cover the cost of transportation and accommodation in the hotel.

Seminar languages: Ukrainian, English.

TWO THEMATIC DISCUSSION PANELS will be held during the two-days seminar:

- 1. CBC regional actors: future impacts and real achievements.** The discussion panel will address the issues of detecting interests and interaction between local and regional actors and cross-border cooperation entities, as well as current opportunities and restrictions for their interaction. Special attention will be paid to the political and administrative elite, and entrepreneurs, as well as their participation in the public discourse and cross-border cooperation processes. Theoretical foundations of examining the CBC concept and their application in contemporary research will be also analyzed.

2. Cross-border cooperation in crises and threats: the resources to overcome them. The panel addresses the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, military and non-military threats faced by the countries participating in CBC, and their role in the development of border areas. The experience of cooperation with the entities from foreign border communities will be analyzed. The best results and problems of implementation of international projects, in the first place those supported by the EU, and their importance for the interaction between the cross-border cooperation entities are to be examined.
